Hi Everyone.

It has been an extraordinary time over the last few months. School from home, work from home, businesses closed and "new normal" like social distancing and wearing masks for everyday activities.

Here at Rossmere Lanes, we have had our challenges like everyone else. Closing the centre on March 17 and not reopening until June 10 has created challenges that could never have been planned for. On top of the closure, May 22 was the day that the flood was discovered. Water from a business located above the bowling centre entered the bowling center through the ceiling. This damaged the approach surface and the substructure forcing us to replace the entire approach surface on all 20 lanes. The good news, we have completed the work and have a brand new textured sliding surface for our bowlers.

Finish what we started:

- Last season sure had an abrupt ending. The plan was to finish the season in some format. Closure of the centre during the season and major repairs that caused an additional 5 week closure to complete the work, sure made it hard to finish our season. However, we still have some time before September and I want to offer a chance to finish the season.
- All of last season members are eligible for these Finish what we Started events. All of these events are no cost to the bowler or family.
 - Bowler of the Year Tournament. From August 24 till August 30. Come and bowl 3 games (PeeWee 2 games) to compete in the Rossmere YBC Bowler of the year tournament. Results will be based on pins over average and all members from last season are eligible to participate.
 - When you bring in your registration for the new season, the family will receive 90 minutes of bowling for 6 people. Please call to reserve your lane as capacity limits are in place.
 - YBC Wind-up. Monday August 31 and Tuesday September 1 will be the awards hand out to conclude the 2019/20 season. Shift times for each day will be 6:00pm and 7:30pm. Please call the centre (204-334-3627) to book your date and shift. Capacity of 22 bowlers and 1 spectator per bowler are being strictly enforced. Bowlers will have the opportunity to bowl on the new approach surface for one hour and receive their awards. Bowlers wishing to bowl together can detail that when they call.

New Season:

- Limits of bowlers allowed per shift will be implemented. As well, we will have to limit the number of spectators allowed as well. The bowling centre will verify the capacity numbers allowed with a Manitoba Health inspector early in September for all leagues and notify bowlers how the shift times will operate.
- YBC League options. We will be offering options for bowlers and families to participate this year. Flexibly for pre-bowling and post-bowling so families with concerns or pre-existing condition. We will provide the safest possible environment for all bowlers and any required accommodations can be discussed with Jamie. Ideas include bowl with your own family (including parents) on Sunday afternoon etc.
- Registration will continue to have payment options. We will be asking parents to have **all fees paid for this season by January 31st**. Discount levels will be offered again. The earlier the payment is received, the greater the discount!
- Chocolates will continue this season as the National Fundraising requirement. Each bowler is **REQUIRED** to sell one case or equivalent support. Grey Cup Tickets, Bingo Bowl, hot dog days and pizza day fundraisers will not be scheduled at this time. Adding items like this to the schedule could be possible during the season.
- All YBC Provincial events will be offered remotely. Hi Low Doubles, Combo and Bowler of the Year will be held in each centre with score submissions to determine Provincial Champions.
- YBC National Events (and their provincial qualifiers) will be scheduled and planned for during the season. These events will look different as capacity limitations will most likely still be in effect.

Registration for the 2020 - 2021 season is here.

Registration:	Can be dropped off at the centre prior to September 4th.		
Program Fees: Full season payment is due by January 31, 2020.			
Discounted if paid by the end of:	September	November	January (full amount)
Peewee	\$300.00	\$325.00	\$350.00
Bantam, Junior or Senior	\$400.00	\$425.00	\$450.00

We ask that a minimum payment of \$100.00 per bowler is made with registration.

Age Categories

Pee Wee:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 8 th birthday as of December 31 st (2013 to 2017)
Bantams:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 11 th birthday as of December 31 st (2010 to 2012)
Juniors:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 15 th birthday as of December 31 st (2006 to 2009)
Seniors:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 20 th birthday as of December 31 st (2001 to 2005)

Shift Times: Please see the registration form for shift time information.

We would encourage each child to bowl in their age grouping, but allowances will be made to accommodate every child where possible. Family members are not usually placed on the same team. The issue with this is when a family is absent, the remaining team will be down to three or less players. Exceptions have been made and these must be discussed with Jamie on registration night.

The first day of the season will be Saturday September 12th.

The Pee Wee bowlers will consist of two games each week for those children under the age of 8. Because of National rules, children only bowling two games per week will **NOT** be eligible to qualify for any tournament that leads to a Provincial Championship. Any bowler starting in the Pee Wee program and wishing to move up to the Bantam Program (3 games - space permitting) must do so by October 1st to be eligible to participate in these events.

If you are planning to be away for a week of bowling, we would encourage your bowler(s) to pre-bowl. Available pre-bowl times can be discussed with staff at the front counter. Pre-bowl can be do anytime ahead of the missed week. Makeup or "back bowling" is possible this season. Please make arrangements with the staff at the desk to schedule your make up weeks. A makeup week can only be accepted two weeks after the missed session.
