- **Program fees are unchanged from last season!** We encourage online registration however, forms and payment can be completed at the centre by September 1st. A minimum \$100.00 payment is required with registration. Online registrants can e-transfer their payment to rossmerelanes@shaw.ca.
- Pre-bowling is available for bowlers to complete their weekly games when they cannot attend on their usual shift time. We will place bowlers on teams according to their age division.
- Registration fees will continue to have payment options. We will be asking parents to have **all fees paid for this season by November 30th**. Discount levels will be offered again. The earlier the payment is received, the greater the discount!
- Chocolates will continue this season as the National Fundraising requirement. Each bowler is **REQUIRED** to sell one case or equivalent support. Our popular Grey cup tickets will return this season and will be available in September. Additional fundraisers may be scheduled for this season if required.
- Rossmere YBC will participate in all Provincial events; Singles, Doubles, High Low Doubles, Combo, Bowler of the Year and the Master Bantam Junior this season.
- Congratulations to the bowlers that attended the National Championships in Regina. Vega and Hayley with Coach Dean won the Junior Girls Doubles National Championships. ANNUAL REGISTRATION DETAILS

Registration for the 2024 - 2025 season is here.

Registration:

Online at www.rossmerelanes.ca or drop off at the centre prior to September 1st.

Program Fees: Full season payment is due by November 30th.

Discounted if paid by the end of:	September	October	November (full amount)
Peewee	\$375.00	\$400.00	\$425.00
Bantam, Junior or Senior	\$475.00	\$500.00	\$525.00

We ask that a minimum payment of \$100.00 per bowler is made with registration.

Age Categories

Peewee:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 8 th birthday as of December 31 st (2017 to 2020)
Bantams:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 11 th birthday as of December 31 st (2014 to 2016)
Juniors:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 15 th birthday as of December 31 st (2010 to 2013)
Seniors:	Those who have <u>NOT</u> reached their 20 th birthday as of December 31 st (2005 to 2009)

Shift Times: Please see the registration form for shift time information.

We will start the season by placing bowlers in teams based on age division when possible.

The first day of the season will be Saturday September 7th.

The Pee Wee bowlers will consist of two games each week for those children under the age of 8. Because of National rules, children only bowling two games per week will NOT be eligible to qualify for any tournament that leads to a Provincial Championship. Any bowler starting in the Pee Wee program and wishing to move up to the Bantam Program (3 games - space permitting) must do so by October 1st to be eligible to participate in these events. National Championships events and their qualifiers require a minimum age of 8 by December 31st.

If you are planning to be away for a week of bowling, we would encourage your bowler(s) to pre-bowl. Available pre-bowl times can be discussed with staff at the front counter. Pre-bowl can be done anytime ahead of the missed week. Makeup or "back bowling" is no longer available.
